GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Kean University offers a variety of scholarships recognizing academic achievement and helps qualified undergraduate and graduate students meet the financial requirements of attending college. This handbook outlines scholarships granted through the University's Office of Scholarship Services, along with application criteria and deadlines.

Scholarships fall into three main categories- *Freshman Merit, Distinguished Freshman, and Kean University Foundation*. Please note that each student is limited to receiving one Freshmen Merit Scholarship or Distinguished Freshmen Scholarship. However, qualified students may receive Kean University Foundation Scholarships in addition to any other funding. Total awards cannot exceed the cost of attendance, which may include expenses such as tuition, fees, room and board.

All students are strongly encouraged to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which will improve their ability to receive needed funding. An application can be completed electronically by visiting www.fafsa.ed.gov

FRESHMAN MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are given based on the University's review of undergraduates' applications for admission to the University. No separate application is needed. Only recent high school graduates admitted as full-time freshmen are eligible. These scholarships are renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study when a cumulative 3.0 GPA is maintained through continuous full-time enrollment. SAT score criteria include Critical Reading (Verbal) and Mathematics only. The Writing score is not considered in the total at this time.

NOTE: Students may receive only one "Freshman Merit" scholarship and it may not be combined with a "Distinguished Freshman" scholarship.

WILLIAM LIVINGSTON SCHOLARSHIP

Full in-state tuition and fees scholarships awarded to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.90 High School GPA (unweighted) and a minimum 1400 SAT.

KEAN SCHOLARSHIP

\$4,000 award given to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.80 GPA (unweighted) and minimum 1350 SAT.

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP

\$3,000 award given to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.70 GPA (unweighted) and minimum 1300 SAT.

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

\$2,500 award given to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.50 GPA (unweighted) and minimum 1250 SAT.

ACADEMIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

\$2,000 award given to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.25 GPA (unweighted) and minimum 1200 SAT.

DR. JAMES E. DORSEY SCHOLARSHIP

A select number of these scholarships are available to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.0 GPA (unweighted) and 1100 SAT and extraordinary extracurricular achievement. Students must file the FAFSA annually to complete eligibility requirements. Awards may equal full tuition and fees minus federal and state grant aid received.

NOTE: Students admitted to the 4+4 B.S./M.D. Scholars Program are not eligible for these awards. The B.S./M.D. program is a flat rate tuition program.

AT-A-GLANCE /

DISTINGUISHED FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

Distinguished Freshman Scholarships are available only to recent high school graduates admitted as full-time freshmen. Applicants must complete a separate scholarship application obtained directly from either the NJCSTME office or the Office of the Dean of the School of Visual and Performing Arts. Note that these awards are competitive and have separate applications. Also note students may only receive either the "Freshman Merit" or "Distinguished Freshman" scholarship.

NEW JERSEY CENTER FOR SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & MATHEMATICS EDUCATION (NJCSTME) SCHOLARSHIPS

Full, in-state tuition scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.0 high school GPA (unweighted) and minimum 1100 SAT (Critical Reading & Math) who matriculate into the Center's five year, combined Bachelor/Master's degree program in science and technology, and pursue either teaching or research careers in science and mathematics. NJCSTME scholarships may be renewable for up to five years in accordance with program requirements.

VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

A select number of full-tuition scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen with a minimum 3.0 unweighted high school GPA who pursue undergraduate degrees in design, fine arts, media & film, music or theatre. These scholarships are renewable for up to four years with a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA and continuous full-time enrollment. Eligible applicants will be required to submit a School of Visual and Performing Arts (SVPA) Scholarship Application and provide a portfolio review, audition, or assessment by SVPA faculty.

KEAN UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Kean University Foundation sponsors over 150 different named scholarships for undergraduate and graduate students. All Foundation scholarships are awarded through a common application. Unless the descriptions indicate otherwise, number of gifts in each category, scholarship availability and award amounts will vary. Most Foundation scholarships are granted as one-time awards. Interested students must complete the Kean University Foundation Scholarship Application.

The 2009-2010 application is available on January 12, 2009 at www.keanfoundation.org and www.kean.edu. It must be postmarked or hand-delivered to the Office of Scholarship Services no later than Monday, March 16, 2009.

NOTE: Incoming Freshman Only scholarships have an application deadline of January 30, 2009.

Adelante Scholarship

Awarded to students who have participated in the Kean University Adelante program who demonstrate financial need.

Patricia M. Barksdale Scholarship

Awarded to juniors and seniors residing in Newark, Roselle, Elizabeth or Linden. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and proven financial need.

Manny Cantor Peace Prize

Granted each year to a student, faculty or staff member who contributes to the cause of promoting international peace, mutual understanding, or inter-group harmony.

William Chaison Award for Dance Theatre Members

Awarded to outstanding members of the Kean Dance Theatre who further their dance training through participation in recognized and approved summer dance programs.

COUNCIL FOR PART-TIME STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Each of the following scholarships is granted to one student per year. Applicants must be matriculated as part-time undergraduates with a minimum 3.0 GPA, who have completed a minimum of 30 credits and demonstrate financial need.

For juniors or seniors who are residents of Union County, N.J., and have a minimum 3.5 GPA. In addition to the Kean University Foundation, scholarship application, students are required to submit an essay describing their educational interests in the area of women's studies.

Elman Family Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students

Awarded to undergraduate and graduate students with a minimum 3.0 GPA. This scholarship is designated for non-traditional age students. Internships may be possible for recipients majoring in education, psychology, and occupational therapy.

EPIC Endowed Scholarship

Given to freshman or sophomore candidates who entered Kean through the Entry Program into College (EPIC). Financial need and academic achievement are determinants for consideration.

Former New Jersey State Troopers Association Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduates who are children or grandchildren of current, retired, or deceased New Jersey State Troopers. Students with 3.0 GPA will receive preference.

Claire Goldstein Memorial Scholarship

Granted to students who exhibit academic excellence, leadership and contributions to extracurricular activities.

HACE Academic Scholarship

Awarded to part-time or full-time sophomores, juniors, or seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA preferred. Must show evidence of positive leadership and extracurricular involvement.

Harwood Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduates with a minimum 3.0 GPA with proven financial need. Preference given to residents of Jersey City, NJ.

Hsu Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduates and open to all majors.

International Student Scholarship

Presented to full-time International undergraduate students with non New Jersey residency only. Applicants must have completed two semesters at Kean at the time of the award, have a minimum 3.0 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

Kean Federation of Teachers Endowed Scholarship

Granted to full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students with a minimum 3.0 GPA and financial need.

Kean University Foundation Endowed and Annual Scholarships

Given to academically talented students in full-time or part-time graduate or undergraduate programs with a 2.75 GPA or higher.

Kean University Transfer Merit Scholarship

This two-year scholarship is for incoming transfer students holding an associate's degree who have a minimum 3.85 GPA.

Kean University Veterans Scholarship

Awarded to a United States Veteran who has received an Honorable Discharge. Preference is given to a veteran who served in active duty in Afghanistan or Iraq.

Jesus Lago-Turon Scholarship

Granted to the student with the highest achievement in the Spanish-speaking section of ECO 1020 "Principles of Economics I."

Lambda Alpha Sigma Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to junior and senior members of the Kean University Lambda Alpha Sigma Honor Society. Students must be enrolled full-time and have completed a minimum of 32 credits at Kean.

Patricia Ann MacNamara Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduate students who are New Jersey residents and have maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Charlotte W. Newcombe Endowed and Annual Scholarships for Mature Women

For female undergraduate students aged 25 or older. Recipients must have at least 60 college credits, a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrate financial need.

Dr. John O'Meara Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to seniors who demonstrate humanitarian qualities in their accomplishments.

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

Granted to incoming transfer students who are Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society members. Candidates must have a minimum 3.5 GPA with an associate's degree by May 1 of the current academic year.

Retired Faculty Endowed Scholarship

Granted to sophomores, juniors, or seniors with financial need.

Fred C. Rummel Foundation Scholarship

For the student who has demonstrated academic achievement, leadership, trustworthiness and character through community-service or high-school activities and has proven financial need. Student must be a graduate of a Union or Essex County High School in New Jersey with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Minimum 3.0 GPA at Kean must be maintained for continuation of scholarship eligibility.

J. Eduardo Saavedra Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to program graduates of Project Adelante. Bilingual undergraduates must have a 3.5 minimum GPA to be considered.

Schering-Plough Foundation Scholarship

Awarded to students with high academic achievement, character and contributions to the community through extracurricular involvement, service and leadership. Candidates must demonstrate financial need.

Student Organization Endowed Scholarship

Scholarships awarded to full-time undergraduates with a minimum 3.0 GPA who have completed a minimum of 18 credits at Kean. Preference given to students with financial need. Successful candidates should demonstrate good character and actively participate in extracurricular programs and leadership activities that benefit the Kean University community.

M. Ernest Townsend Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to a sophomore who exhibits academic excellence.

Steven J. Weiss Endowed Memorial Scholarship

For freshmen, sophomores or juniors who demonstrate academic excellence, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, are involved in University community activities and exhibit leadership qualities.

Wilf Family Foundation Scholarship

Granted to 12 full-time students with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

INCOMING FRESHMEN ONLY

NOTE: These scholarships are available to full-time Fall 2009 freshmen only and require a complete 2009-2010 Freshman Scholarship Application to be submitted by January 30, 2009 to the Office of Scholarship Services. Complete applications received after that date and until March 16 will be considered for general and departmental awards also open to returning students. Ronald L. and Susan Applbaum Endowed Scholarship

Recipients must be from New Jersey with a 3.0 minimum GPA. Awarded to incoming freshmen in the upper 10th percentile of their graduating class.

Dr. Reynold E. and Mary B. Burch Endowed Scholarship

Granted to unmarried students who are recent high-school graduates and enrolled in health-related fields. Must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Richard Cudina '78 Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded in memory of Richard Cudina, a Kean alumnus who was killed in the World Trade Center attacks on September 11, 2001.

Jane D'Onofrio Scholarship

Awarded to students with a minimum 3.0 GPA and minimum 1000 SAT who demonstrate financial need.

Anne Evans Estabrook Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to entering freshmen deemed to be among the best and brightest high school seniors in the areas of academic, community service or athletic achievement. Minimum 3.0 GPA must be maintained for continuation of scholarship eligibility.

Ken and Anne Estabrook Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to an incoming freshman enrolled in the bachelor of science in science and technology education program with a minimum 3.0 GPA and 1200 SAT. Students must maintain a minimum 3.2 GPA to earn annual renewal for up to 5 years.

Ruth Keeler Gannon Scholarship Endowment

This four-year scholarship is for students who demonstrate excellent academic standing, commitment to community and leadership abilities.

Arthur Geilfuss Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to full-time freshmen in the College of Business and Public Administration with a minimum 3.4 GPA and SAT score of 1000.

Emma Geilfuss Endowed Scholarship

Applicants must be full-time freshmen in the College of Business and Public Administration with a minimum 3.4 GPA and SAT score of 1000.

Mabel G. Holmes Endowed Scholarship

This award is for students from Elizabeth (N.J.) High School who are incoming freshmen ranked in the upper third of their class demonstrating financial need.

Kean University Foundation Endowed and Annual Scholarships

Given to academically talented students in full-time or part-time graduate or undergraduate programs with a 2.75 GPA or higher.

Divina Malanga Endowed Memorial Scholarship

Given to females from Elizabeth (N.J.) High School who are incoming freshmen ranked in the upper third of their class and demonstrate financial need.

Edward and Dolly Miltner Endowed Scholarship

Applicants must be incoming freshmen who have attended Fort Lee (N.J.) High School for a minimum of three years, with a minimum 3.0 GPA and who demonstrate financial need. Preference is given to education majors.

Lennie Pierro Fine Arts Scholarship

Awarded to incoming freshmen with intended majors in fine arts. A departmental portfolio review is required.

Senior Class Scholarship

This scholarship is granted to freshmen who exhibit academic excellence with a minimum 3.5 GPA. Preference is given to students who are not eligible for traditional financial aid and participate in well-rounded extracurricular and civic activities.

Damarys Vazquez Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an incoming female freshman majoring in early childhood education. The recipient must be a resident of Elizabeth, N.J.

BUSINESS AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION MAJORS

Abner and Norma Benisch Endowed Scholarship

Granted to undergraduate business or education majors exhibiting and outstanding level of drive and personal initiative through campus, extracurricular, and community involvement. A 3.25 GPA is required and preference is given to Essex County residents.

Dawood Farahi Public Service Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to students with a minimum 3.0 GPA majoring in public administration, criminal justice, occupational therapy or nursing.

Jolly Family Scholarship

Granted to sophomore, junior, or senior public administration majors with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference given to students with Kean extracurricular involvement, particularly in student government.

Edward McColgan Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to students majoring within the College of Business & Public Administration and preparing for a career in business. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA with proven financial need.

New Jersey Association of Public Accountants Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduate accounting majors with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to New Jersey residents living in Hudson, Union or Essex counties.

Northfield Bank Foundation Scholarship

Awarded to business and finance related majors with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Recipients must be New Jersey or New York residents from Avenel, East Brunswick, Linden, Milltown, Monroe, Rahway, Woodbridge, or Staten Island.

Hugh and Edna Pearce Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduate and graduate students majoring in public administration.

Wiss Edward W. O'Connell Scholarship

Granted to sophomore, junior, and senior accounting majors with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Hoy Yee Scholarship

Awarded to juniors majoring in business or science. Students must have a 3.0 GPA. Preference given to residents of Mercer and Middlesex counties with a demonstrated financial need.

EDUCATION MAJORS

Abner and Norma Benisch Endowed Scholarship

(see complete listing under College of Business and Public Administration)

Dr. Nickie B. Berson Special Education Endowed Scholarship

Given to junior or senior undergraduates with a minimum 2.5 GPA, who are enrolled full-time in the educator of individuals with disabilities program.

Dr. Sharon Brendzel Endowed Memorial Scholarship

Granted to students majoring in education and preparing to teach in the sciences. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and financial need.

Patricia Ingram Campbell Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to education majors who have exhibited academic excellence.

Bill Dioguardi Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to sophomore, junior, or senior male physical education majors. Eligible students must have a 3.0 GPA.

Dorsey-Gaines Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to sophomores, juniors or seniors majoring in education and preparing for a teaching career. Recipients must be New Jersey residents with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Frank J. Esposito Social Science Scholarship

Awarded to junior and senior teaching majors concentrating in middle or high school social studies. Students have a minimum 3.5 GPA.

E. Alma Flagg Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to two students each year. Applicants must be English and education majors from Newark, N.J.

G. Evelyn Foster Endowed Memorial Scholarship

For students in the Early Childhood Education Program who have completed 60 credits. Applicants should have work experience in a child-care center, a minimum 3.2 GPA, and proven financial need.

Giordano Family Scholarship

Awarded to undergraduate students with declared majors in speech, language, and hearing sciences. Students should have completed four courses in the major. Preference will be given to students committed to the field of speech therapy as demonstrated through volunteerism, outreach, or other activity in the field.

John Edward Haffly Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to a senior studying special education who has demonstrated academic proficiency, community service and shows evidence of future leadership in the field.

Hazel H. Hardgrove Music Education Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to a senior music-education major who plans to teach in a New Jersey public school. Student must be a U.S. citizen from Union County, N.J., and maintain full-time enrollment with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Preference given to residents of Springfield, N.J. planning to teach at the elementary-school level.

Dorothy and George Hennings Endowed Scholarship in Education

Supports students in elementary or science education who have completed 18 semester hours, have a minimum GPA of 3.3 and are committed to excellence.

Ruth Horowitz Endowed Scholarship

Granted to senior-year students majoring in early-childhood education who are New Jersey residents with a minimum 3.5 GPA and are able to demonstrate financial need.

Thelma Kaplan Endowed Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must be sophomore, junior or senior students pursuing degrees in the helping professions, such as counseling, nursing, education or social work, have a minimum 3.0 GPA and proven financial need.

Maxine Lane Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to a junior with a minimum 3.5 GPA and proven financial need. Student must demonstrate career goals in the fields of human health or education.

Helen Longacre Endowed Scholarship

Awarded to part-time elementary education majors planning to teach on the elementary school level with proven financial need.

Joseph and Rosella Morrissey Scholarship

Awarded to juniors and seniors majoring in education and preparing for a teaching career in grades K-5. Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Lucy Jajosky Orfan Endowed Scholarship

Granted to seniors majoring in elementary education with an academic major in mathematics and seeking K-5 or 5-8 certification. Preference will be given to K-5 students. Must have a 3.3 GPA or higher and financial need. Preference is given to New Jersey residents.

Sadie Richman Gerontology Scholarship

Awarded to a student in the gerontology collateral program, who intends to pursue a career in aging services. Applicant must have completed a minimum of 12 credits and have a minimum 3.5 GPA.

Helio E. Rosete Memorial Endowed Scholarship

For students in the educator of individuals with disabilities program with a minimum 3.0 GPA who express interest in a career working with adults with disabilities.

Sophie and Edward Sheplak Endowed Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must be undergraduates in education or human services with a minimum 3.0 GPA, who are financing their own education, have financial hardship in the family and show a record of volunteering in community-service activities. Preference is given to female candidates.

Sandra Castaldo Williams Endowed Scholarship for Non-Traditional Students

Awarded to non-traditional (age 25 or older) undergraduates with proven financial need. Preference given to students pursuing a career in education.

HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES MAJORS

W. John Bauer Endowed Scholarship in English

Awarded to current sophomore, junior, and senior undergraduates with a declared major in English. Students have a minimum 3.0 GPA and proven financial need.

Marc Birger Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a sophomore, junior, or senior communications major with a minimum 3.0 GPA and proven financial need. The recipient will have demonstrated leadership and service in the communications department.

Communications Scholarship

Awarded to junior and senior communications majors with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Francis Farber Scholarship
